MCIR Updates

• MCIR has been updated to support Online Site Re-Enrollment. (Ref. #870, 872, 873, 1019, 1020)

- The MCIR Perinatal Hep B Prevention Program (PHBPP) module case Edit Person Language field has been updated to use the MCIR Language list above. Similarly, the field supports "type-ahead" autofill to select a Language. (Ref. #1333)
- The MCIR Internal Provider Support and Data Quality staff now has the ability to independently process vaccination file imports/exports from Wisconsin. Previously our technical vendor had to process these files. (Ref. #934, 936, 1031)

Bug Fixes

- Display of VFC search results has been updated to sort Newest Orders first. (Ref. #204)
- A typo in header of the Site Certification Expiring Listing Report was corrected to "...as of {Today's Date + 3 months. Previously it displayed a date that was "- 3 months." (Ref. #950)
- The Batch Report screen was missing the check box to "Add to Roster." This has been corrected. (Ref. #1099)
- An issue with selecting an LHD site for adoption processing for internal MCIR staff has been corrected. The correct LHD sites will now be displayed when staff are processing adoptions. (Ref. #1145)
- An error has been corrected to properly handle HL7 messages with H1N1 (127) and PMC (Sanofi).

- If Product Maintenance-Product Details page is updated and **Submit** is clicked, the existing shortage dose volume amounts are not nullified. This was causing issues with inventory calculations. (Ref. 1685)
