Updates

The Michigan Federally Recognized Tribes have been added to MCIR Race options. (Ref. #1881, #2036)

In SIRS, the School/Childcare General Information page now properly displays the Language label and value. (Ref. #1905)

In SIRS, the School/Childcare Edit School/Childcare Info page Language selection list has been updated. (Ref. #1906)

The label "Gender" has been updated to "Sex" throughout the MCIR system. (Ref. #1981)

When a COVID vaccination is given and recorded on the day of birth, the system was presenting a processing exception error. This impacted the ability to run QI reports. This issue has been resolved. (Ref. #1524)

Change Series Advise Verbiage when an Error Occurs (Ref. #2091)

There were some occasional instances when COVID-19 vaccinations that were administered did not meet MCIR schedule recommendations, age-appropriate vaccine recommendations, or administered before time of Emergency Use Authorization, there was not a notification or screen indication in MCIR of this issue when it occurred. Analysis was done for these “failed forecasts” that impacted other antigens when doing reports in MCIR. In order to not disrupt other antigens or reports, it was determined that there was a need to develop a status for these COVID-19 vaccinations as “Unknown”. This would allow MCIR staff and providers time to address issues with the reported vaccination, and to not disrupt other important features of MCIR.

Examples showing when display will appear as “unknown”.

Example one- Doses reported close in time – in this instance need time to contact provider to determine correct administration date. This situation led to a “failed forecast”. In order to not disrupt other MCIR features the status will show “unknown” to allow time to address issues.

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Bug Fixes

The following reported issues have been fixed and now function properly:

- Local Health Department Non-Medical Waiver – When modifying an existing waiver, you no longer receive the “Error Processing Event” message. (Ref. #2097)
- A person that receives their HepB shots at 18-19 years of age-appropriate vaccine at time of administration is assessed as complete. The system was improperly assessing a fourth dose at age 20. (Ref. #1672)
- A correction has been made to the MCIR new user registration email. (Ref. #1737)
- A correction has been made to properly record Race from HL7 so the CHILD RACE table populates. (Ref. #2032)
