## Updates

- MCIR has been updated to properly re-assess children every 7 days who are incomplete or provisional. With this update, the MDE reports due March 31 should include accurate re-assessment information.\* (Ref. #2216)

- MCIR has been updated to properly handle failed COVID forecast for adolescent, caused by parent refusal. (Ref. #2243)

Case reported that adolescent with two (2) doses of COVID-19 PFR-BNT 30mcg/0.3mL (CVX 218) and Parent Refusal resulted in COVID-19 UNKNOWN status.

Research determined that the licensure date of Comirnaty product was causing the failure to forecast. Patient and/or parent refusals do not impact forecasting of vaccines. MCIR is now using the date of adolescent 12- 16 years olds authorization for PFR COVID vaccine 5/10/21 for assessment and forecasting.
