Dedup	Deduplication refers to the process of reviewing and systematically eliminating: 1) duplicate Immunization Information System (IIS) person records, and/or 2) duplicate vaccine encounters within a person's IIS record.

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EHR	Electronic Health Record is an electronic version of a patient's medical history, including immunizations. (see also EMR)	
EIR	Ending Inventory Report is a MCIR report used to account for the movement of all vaccine lots in a specific balance period (i.e., during the selected balance cycle).	
EMR	Electronic Medical Record is an electronic version of a patient's medical history, including immunizations. (see also EHR)	
EPSDT	Early Periodic Screening Diagnosis and Treatment	EPSDT
ESSR	Electronic Submission Summary Report is a MCIR report detailing HL7 immunization transactions and related inventory effects.	
End User	End User is the individual utilizing a fully-functioning product (i.e., the IIS).	
GUI	General User Interface refers to the computer system or user application (see also UI).	
HEDIS	Health Employer Data and Information Set	HEDIS
HIE	Health Information Exchange is the electronic transmission of health records and data sets between healthcare-related organizations, in accordance with national standards.

ID	Identification refers to various health information identification numbers which may be retained within the IIS. Examples: IIS Site ID or IIS, EHR/EMR or MDHHS program ID assigned to a person.

Migrant	A person or family member moving from place to place due to seasonal work.

OBRD	Onboarding is the process of working with IIS IT to set up and test immunization data from an external data source to the IIS. Onboarding is required before a site is approved for HL7 data submission to the IIS.	HL7 information at www.mcir.org
Overdue	Overdue refers to a person's immunization status, based on the recommended vaccine schedules.	
P4M	Petition for Modification is a document used to request necessary changes to a person's IIS record.	
POC	Point of Contact refers to the person's Responsible Party.	
PROD	Production refers to the IIS database the end-user access.	
PROV	Provider refers to the physician or medical office utilizing the IIS.	
R/R	Reminder/Recall is an IIS function (method) used to effectively ensure persons receive timely vaccine administrations, based on the recommend vaccine schedules.	
SIRS	School Information Recordkeeping System is a component of the Michigan IIS which is used by schools and childcares to maintain	

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	immunization records and assess for required vaccinations, based on state requirements for childcare/school attendance.	
Site	Site refers to a medical practice (“provider office”), school, childcare, HCO or other facility type with access rights to the IIS.	
UI	User Interface refers to the computer system or user application (see also GUI).	
UTD	Up-to-Date refers to a person’s immunization status, based on the recommended vaccine schedules.	
VFC	Vaccines for Children Program	VFC
VIM	Vaccine Inventory Module is a component of the IIS used to track an immunizing healthcare office’s vaccine inventory.
