Impact of COVID-19 on Immunizations: National Perspective from CDC's Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Reports

Effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Routine Pediatric Vaccine Ordering and Administration — United States, 2020

- Published May 15, 2020
- Substantial reduction in VFC-funded pediatric vaccine ordering
- Decline in vaccine administration among children

- Published May 22, 2020
- Vaccine administration increased among persons aged <24 months starting the week of April 19–25, as the number of new COVID-19 cases declined ad returned to comparable levels in May

Percent Change in Doses Administered in 2020 Compared To the 2018-2019 Average by Age Group And Month, MCIR



The largest percent decreases were observed in April with adolescents aged 9 through 18 at 85.6%, children 2 through 8 at 82.7%, and adults 19 through 105 at 82.2%.

 - Options are flexible
 - Only pulls those overdue for vaccines



Things to Keep in Mind About Reminder

- Not based on Immunization Assessment, but by Age
- Patient Medical Home
- Roster vs. Provider ID
- Effect of Patient Status



Patient Status

• From the patient General Information page click Edit above the patients name.





- If you are not the medical home you will only have the option of Active or Deceased.
- No action is required.

- Reminder/Recall reports show information on how well people responded to the letters.
- Allow for additional data clean up after patients don't respond to three recalls.
